Coronavirus Vaccine

A Coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine developed by Pfizer/BioNTech has been approved for use in the UK.

This vaccine has met the strict standards of safety, quality and effectiveness set out by the independent Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA).

Although other vaccines are being developed they will only be available once they have been thoroughly tested to make sure they are safe and effective.

Vaccine Safety

Any vaccine (including the Covid-19 vaccine) must go through all the clinical trials and safety checks that all other licensed medicines go through. The UK has some of the highest safety standards in the world.

Vaccines will only be used if they are approved by the MHRA. The MHRA has been monitoring every stage of the Covid-19 vaccine's development.

Who will get the vaccine?

We will contact all patients as they become eligible for the Covid-19 vaccine.

Our first clinic will be held at the STEAM Museum on 15th January 2021. This will be for patients of the Wyvern Health Partnership practices that are over 80 years old.

Information for Patients

Once we have contacted you and booked you an appointment in the COVID vaccination clinic please ensure that you arrive within your allocated time slot, this way we can ensure that social distancing measures are in place.

Please arrive on your own or with one other person if you require support.

We are asking all patients to wear a face covering. This is not only to protect yourself, but others around you.

We are also asking patients to wear loose fitting clothing that is easy to remove, so that we are able to give the injection in your upper arm in a timely manner. Please ensure that you dress in warm clothing as there may be a queue, but this fast moving as we will have several clinicians that are working within the building.
